

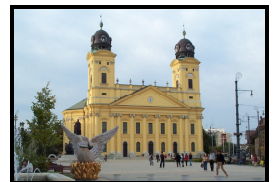

# May 2011 Prayer Calendar for Eastern Hungary

*The items below, listed in date order, give more information about the prayer requests on the calendar.*

- 1 **Tiszafüred** [TĚ-sō-few-rĕd] This city of about 12,000 has no evangelical church; one is being planted partnering with a HU pastor. Many tourists come, especially from Germany and Italy, creating potential for the Gospel to spread to other countries.
- 2 **Flood victims** Our area is set in a flood plain, so every year there are some problems. This past year the floods were even more devastating than usual, and many people continue to suffer from financial and other hardships.
- 3 **Seekers and students** Names have been changed for privacy. These are people with whom our team has regular contact.
- 4 **Connections Coffeehouse** provides English conversation, coffee, tea, snacks and fun events each Thursday evening in Debrecen; many spiritual conversations and questions come up.  
**Nádudvar English Club** meets Saturdays from 10:00-11:00 a.m. This is a program of the Nádudvar culture house and we help by providing native English speakers. It is a needed service, and we are also making new friends in the town.
- 6 **Angel Wings** ([www.aripideinger.com](http://www.aripideinger.com)) Romanian foundation *Aripa de Inger* [ō-RĚP-dĕ-OON-jĕr] reaches out to young people through aviation/adventure camps. In their 11 years of ministry they have made a huge impact on many lives.
- 7 **Hungarians in Romania** Hungary once included what is now Romania; about 1.5 million Hungarians still live there.
- 8 **Nádudvar** [NAHD-ood-vōr] More than 9,000 live in this former communist stronghold; an evangelical church is needed.
- 9 **Roma (Gypsy)** More than 400,000 Roma live in eastern Hungary, most in very poor conditions. Although our main work is not with the Roma, they are included in almost every outreach project that we do.
- 11 **Timothy Leadership Training Institute** ([www.timothyleadershiptraining.org](http://www.timothyleadershiptraining.org)) Pastors and lay leaders will be trained to build viable and healthy congregations and communities in the spirit of 2 Timothy 2:2.
- 13 **The Grain Game** ([www.thegraingame.org](http://www.thegraingame.org)) We will be helping with the children's Bible camps in Hungary and Slovakia.
- 14 **Hungarians in Serbia** Parts of northern Serbia formerly belonged to Hungary, and many Hungarians are still there.
- 15 **Balmazújváros** [BŌL-mōz-ooĕ-vaah-rōsh] A city of about 18,000 with no evangelical church.
- 16 **Community development projects** There are many needs among the people, but time and resources are limited.
- 18 **Hajdúszoboszló English Camp** [HĪ-doo-sō-bō-slō] This will be the 6th year we and volunteers have partnered with the national church to provide an English camp for the community; the pastor tells us it has had a great impact.
- 20 **Good Sports International** ([www.goodsportsinternational.blogspot.com](http://www.goodsportsinternational.blogspot.com)) Our team has worked with Good Sports several times, assisting with a youth baseball team and in orphanage ministry, and hopes to work closer together in the future.
- 21 **Hungarians in the Ukraine** The Ukrainian region that borders Hungary once belonged to HU, and many still live there.
- 22 **House church** is the only model that's 100% reproducible in any culture or country. Pray that students will see that they can start a house church wherever they go in the world.
- 23 **Volunteers** E. HU has 4.7 million people, as well as those across the borders, and our team is small. Volunteers are vital!
- 25 **Four Senses Theater** Drama outreach, previously very successful on the university campus and in demand in other towns in our area. Due to scheduling conflicts and lack of workers had to be discontinued in spring 2011.
- 27 **Logos Language School** (<http://tinyurl.com/logos-en>) is a new school in Debrecen that we partner with for special projects.
- 28 **Hungarians in Slovakia** Hungarians are the largest ethnic minority, a result of the borders having been changed.
- 29 **Pac Kerti Mission** [PŌTS-kĕrt-ĕ] A church plant by Debrecen Baptist Church. We are trying to find partners to assist them.
- 30 **The Hathcock family** will arrive in mid-June, transferring in from another country. Pray for their adjustment, language learning, and for the Lord to prepare the hearts of those they will begin ministering to. They will be in Budapest for a year beginning their language studies before moving to Debrecen.
- 31 **Team members** Pray for Seth & Aubree as they are finishing their internships and transitioning back to life in the States during May, and for Stacia as she completes her Journeyman assignment in August. Pray for Gary & Carolyn as they deal with all the changes and continue ministries with a much smaller team; they will also be preparing for a transition, as their six-month Stateside Assignment will begin in December of this year.
